April 30, 2012 (Day 1) | Overnight Flight

Your journey begins with an overnight flight to Amsterdam, “Venice of the North.”

May 1, 2012 (Day 2) | Amsterdam, Netherlands

Also on display are living cultural exhibitions representing more than 30 countries from around the world. (Breakfast, Dinner)

May 4, 2012 (Day 5) | Amsterdam/Brussels, Belgium

After breakfast, travel to Brussels, the capital of Belgium and home of the EU Parliament. Upon arrival in Brussels, enjoy a panoramic tour of the city including the Royal Gardens and castle, Atomium, Arch of Triumph, the Art Nouveau houses, and of course, the world-famous Grand Palace.
