Your Alaskan Adventure Itinerary

July 8, 2012 (Day 1) | Pennsylvania to Fairbanks

The transfer leaves central Pennsylvania for the Baltimore International Airport. Upon your arrival in Fairbanks, you will be transferred to your hotel for a relaxing overnight stay.

July 9, 2012 (Day 2) | Fairbanks

Your day is filled with exciting activities while on a Fairbanks City Tour. Explore the El Dorado Gold Mine where you will pan for gold and enjoy a cruise on the Riverboat Discovery Sternwheeler. Stay a second night in Fairbanks.



July 10, 2012 (Day 3) | Fairbanks/Denali

Travel on the Wilderness Express, with glass-domed traincars, through spectacular wilderness to Denali. In the afternoon, take an exciting seven-hour Tundra Wilderness Tour deep into Denali National Park. Keep an eye out for caribou, moose, bear and other wildlife along your path. Overnight in Denali. Don't forget your binoculars!!



July 11, 2012 (Day 4) | Denali/Talkeetna

Your morning is open for optional activities, such as Nenana River Rafting or the Husky Homestead Tour. In the afternoon, sit back and relax onboard the Wilderness Express on a scenic journey to Talkeetna. Enjoy a relaxing evening or nature walk at the Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge.

July 12, 2012 (Day 5) | Talkeetna/Anchorage

In the morning you will travel via deluxe motorcoach to Anchorage. Enjoy a tour of the city, including a visit to the Alaska Native Heritage Center, where you'll learn about Alaska's first people. In the evening, explore this cosmopolitan city filled with museums and shops. You will have an overnight stay in Anchorage.

July 13, 2012 (Day 6) | Anchorage/Seward

Travel by deluxe motorcoach to the fishing town of Seward. Here you will board *Radiance of the Seas* to begin your cruise adventure. Ship departs Seward at 8:00 PM.

July 14, 2012 (Day 7) | Cruising/Hubbard Glacier

Cruise the Hubbard Glacier from 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM. The longest river of ice in North America, the Hubbard Glacier is also one of the most active glaciers of its kind in Alaska. And since our ships are designed to provide our guests with the best viewing possible, you'll be able to see this massive natural wonder, with its 1,350 square miles of blue ice, from just about anywhere on the ship.

July 15, 2012 (Day 8) | Juneau

Arrive: 9:00 a.m. - Depart: 9:00 p.m.

Juneau, the capital of Alaska, was founded during a gold rush in 1880. Today, the former gold-mining town counts among its riches some of Alaska's most spectacular scenery. Nestled at the foot of Mt. Juneau in the Alaskan Panhandle, it faces the water from the mainland side of Gastineau Channel. Several magnificent fjords are located along the channel coast, and the majestic Mendenhall Glacier, a favorite of visitors, is nearby. There are many excursion options for Juneau.



July 16, 2012 (Day 9) | Skagway

Arrive: 7:00 a.m. - Depart: 8:30 p.m.

When gold was discovered in the Klondike region of the Yukon Territory, (just across the border from Alaska), it resulted in the historic Gold Rush of 1898. As thousands of gold-crazed adventurers sought the best jumping-off spot for their arduous trek, they found the deepest penetration by boat was at the northern tip of the Lynn Canal. That is how Skagway was born. There are 30 excursion options for Skagway or you can explore on your own.

July 17, 2012 (Day 10) | Icy Strait Point

Arrive: 7:00 a.m. - Depart: 4:00 p.m.

Imagine viewing a picturesque Alaskan bay from the doorstep of a historic cannery, when suddenly, a humpback whale surfaces just yards offshore. And that's just part of the beauty of Icy Strait Point. Among other things, you can see the fascinating Native Heritage Center, search for brown bear, flightsee, mountain bike, and get in some fabulous fishing.

July 18, 2012 (Day 11) | Ketchikan

Arrive: 9:00 a.m. - Depart: 6:00 p.m.

Ketchikan originated as an Indian fish saltery, but the town's growth began when it became a supply base and entry port for miners during the 1898 gold rush to the Klondike. Much of the town's colorful past is still evident, especially in the nearby Indian villages where you'll see colorfully carved totem poles and hear the fascinating legends that surround them.

July 19, 2012 (Day 12) | Cruising/The Inside Passage

Cruising through the Inside Passage is really what has made Alaska cruising so popular. This trip captures so much of what people love about Alaska- misty rain forests, ghostly blue fjords, and spirited communities that celebrate their varied heritage. Be sure to take in every view as you sail through one of the most beautiful parts of North America.

July 20, 2012 (Day 13) | Vancouver

Arrive: 7:00 a.m.

Disembark this morning and head to the airport for your return flight to Baltimore. (Upon arrival in Baltimore the motorcoach transfer to central Pennsylvania.)
